Position Rationale

Reporting to a Foreman and an Equipment Trainer, a Dozer/Crawler Operator is responsible for safe and efficient operation of a dozer. A Dozer/Crawler Operator will push and level soil and control direction and angle of equipment to move rocks and debris, as instructed.

Position Accountabilities

Equipment Operation:

- Operate a dozer and other heavy equipment in a safe and appropriate manner.
- Perform daily maintenance and safety checks of equipment; perform routine cleaning and maintenance to ensure smooth operation.
- Understand, interpret and follow directions from supervisors as to required work area.
- Operate dozer controls to regulate height and angle of a dozer blade and lower ripper to loosen packed soil to permit grading.
- Ensure sound understanding of issues involving ground disturbance.
- Drive a dozer in successive passes over construction surface to raise or lower terrain to specified grade following markings on grade stakes or hand signals.
- Use a dozer to level soil, move rock/ debris and oil.
- Ensure a dozer is in proper gear and not moving too fast for working conditions.
- Operate other heavy equipment and other construction related duties as required.
