<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Operate a tandem axle truck, including loading, transporting, and unloading materials, tools and equipment under varying traffic and road conditions.</li> <li>Complete pre-trip inspection of equipment including checking oil, fuel levels, tires, lights, lubricating and safety operations.</li> <li>Use various truck attachments such as plows, sanders, side delivery conveyor and water tank.</li> <li>Use a tandem truck as required.</li> <li>Record fuel levels, mileage, and fuels; maintaining simple records.</li> </ul>	



- Aid crew members in performing their duties.
- Assist in performance of and maintenance tasks.
- Drive a City of Calgary vehicle to and from job sites.
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned.

**Technical Knowledge:**

- Know methods, techniques, hand/power tools, materials, equipment used in construction and maintenance.
- Have general knowledge of city, provincial and national safety regulations.
- Be familiar with of heavy trucks, equipment, and various attachments.
- Be aware of load limits and proper methods used in loading, transporting, and unloading of heavy trucks.

**Working Environment / Conditions:**
